1) Read Charles Mills' "But what are you really?" In this series of problem cases, cases I-III all involve someone with black parents but who other people sometimes (or always) think is white. What is the race of each of these three people? If you think any of them is *really* white, explain why. If you think that none of them is white, then do you think it is possible for two parents who are black to have a biological child who is white? Under what circumstances? You can make the case as outlandish as you want.

2) After reading the chapter, come up with a question that you want answered or a topic that you would like to be discussed. This could be something that the chapters forced you think about or it could be something that you thought was particularly confusing in the chapters.
